May 18th, 2018 | 10 am

Roll was taken.

An overview was provided on the May Stakeholder Engagement Workshops. There were overall 86 attendees. The questions from the workshop breakout groups will be sent to those on the Steering Committee who could not attend the workshops and to anyone who wants to make further input. There will be a Stakeholder Engagement Report that encompasses the information from the May workshops and eventually the August workshops. Some of the main points gathered from the workshops May 7th and 8th were code changes, checklists for resiliency, being more proactive instead of reactive, education for public, elected officials, contractors/developers etc., having an incentive for and developing a resilient homes program, addressing the gap in manufacturing jobs and fostering apprenticeships, linking open space and green infrastructure with stormwater infrastructure, and employee/employer disaster plan development. The August workshop dates of August 20th and 21st was briefly discussed and the intent to send out information to the invite list on Monday. By this date there will be a draft of the Action Plan and this would be a working session to take a deep dive into the action plan and work towards its finalization.
